## Mission

EPS is a non-political organization that supports 31 Mainland Coast Salish First Nations actualize the 4 pillars of Emergency Management at the local & regional levels. We advocate for increased capacity for First Nations communities & the full realization of DRIPA & representation of Mainland Coast Salish values in all regional emergency management activities. The EPS seeks to create a Emergency Management Strategy for all hazards & climate change based in the Sendai Framework and rooted in UNDRIP that encompasses the values & priorities of all 31 Mainland Coast Salish Communities.

## First Steps

Our First Steps are to assist 31 Mainland Coast Salish communities identify flood risk & management priorities with a Coast Salish worldview that includes environmental and cultural considerations through a coordinated regional Emergency Management Plan, which utilizes a Sendai Action Framework & ensures disaster risk reduction across the four pillars of emergency management: mitigation, preparedness, response & recovery. We endeavor to ensure Mainland Coast Salish communities and values are incorporated in decision making across emergency management activities across the region.
